Košarkaški klub Partizan je najuspešniji kolektiv u našoj zemlji. U svojoj bogatoj istoriji, dugoj više od šest decenija KK Partizan je osvojio čak 30 trofeja. Crno-beli košarkaši 15 puta su bili prvaci države – 1976, 1979, 1981, 1987, 1992, 1995, 1996, 1997, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007 i 2008, devet puta osvajači nacionalnog Kupa – 1979, 1989, 1992, 1994, 1995, 1999, 2000, 2002 i 2008, tri puta pobednici Kupa Radivoja Koraća – 1978, 1979, 1989, a prvaci Jadranske lige bili su 2007 i 2008.

Najsajjniji trofej u bogatoj klupskoj riznici, titulu pravak Evrope, osvojili su u Istanbulu 1992. godine.

KK Partizan je izrastao u najpoznatije košarkaško ime sa naših prostora, sa velikim ugledom u evropskim i svetskim okvirima. The “Black and White” players were the state champions fifteen times (1976, 1979, 1981, 1997, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2008), nine times (1979, 1989, 1992, 1994, 1995, 1999, 2000, 2002 and 2008), three times they won the European Cup Radivoje Korac (1978, 1979, 1989) and they were twice (2007, 2008) champions of the Adriatic League. The most significant trophy the club has won is the European Champion's Cup in Istanbul in 1992.

BC Partizan has grown into the most famous basketball brand from Serbia and team acclaimed both on the European and World levels. 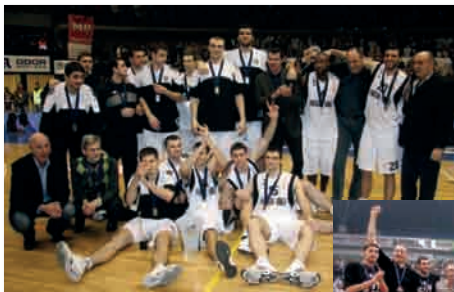

## Европски Партизан

Сјајни Партизан у четвртфиналу и историји



Sezona 2007/08, u košarkaškom klubu Partizan ostaće zapisana kao jedna od najuspešnijih u istoriji. Osvajena su tri trofeja, prvo u Kupu Radivoja Koraća, potom u Jadranskoj ligi, a sve je ukrašeno 15. titulom prvaka države, sedmom uzastopnom. U takmičenju najboljih timova Evrope crno-beli su zaustavljeni na korak od plasmana na fajnal for.

Kada su košarkaši Partizana i stručni štab krenuli da se pripremaju, malo ko im je predviđao tako sjajne rezultate. Sjajnom igrom zaslužno su zauzeli prvo mesto u ligaškom delu regionalnog takmičenja, uz samo dva poraza. Uporedo, postali su hit evroligaškog takmičenja plasiravši se u TOP 16. Pre početka druge faze Evrolige i plej-ofa NLB lige, crno-beli su doneli prvi trofej u Humsku. Osvajanjem Kupa Radivoja Koraća u Nišu navestili su šampionski niz. Prelazni pehar namenjen pobedniku Jadranske lige zadržao se u Ljubljani samo nekoliko dana. Posle blistavih partija crno-belih i pobeđa nad Olimpijom i Hemofarmom, vraćen je na isto mesto, u trofejnu salu u Humskoj. Partizan je dokazao da je najbolji tim u regionu.

Paralelno sa uspesima u ova dva takmičenja, košarkaši i stručni štab pravili su velike podvige u evropskoj eliti, iza sebe ostavivši gigante poput Panathinaikosa i madridskog Reala. Igrama Partizana i atmosferi u Pioniru divila se cela Evropa. Za plasman među četiri najuspešnijih kluba Starog kontinenta nedostajala je samo jedna stepenica, pored protivnika naš tim je imao i dodatne prepreke, koje su bile nepremostive. Kruna uspešne sezone došla je uz velike napore. Partizan je osvojio 15. titulu prvaka države, 7. uzastopnu, i obezbedio ponovno učešće na najvažnijem evropskom klupskom takmičenju – Evroligi.



Season 2007/2008 stands out as one of the most successful in the BC Partizan history.

BC Partizan won three trophies, The Korac Cup, then Adriatic League and finally as a cherry on a pie BC Partizan won the 15th Championship of Serbia in the clubs history and the 7th in a row. In the championship of the best European Clubs "Black and Whites" are held down on a brink of qualifying to the Final Four.

When the players and the Coaching Staff started their training preparations for the season, hardly anyone could predict such good results. They played fantastically and deserved the first place in the Regular season of the regional competition, suffering just two lost games. In the meantime, they became a marvel of the Euroleague taking their place in the TOP 16. BC Partizan brought its first trophy in the new season in Humska just before the second phase of Euroleague and Play Offs of Adriatic League began. Winning the Korac Cup in Nis they just suggested the forthcoming trophies. The trophy that belongs to the winner of the Adriatic League stayed in Ljubljana just a few days until Partizan claimed it for the second time in a row. After wins over Olimpija and Hemofarm it is taken back in the Trophy Hall. Partizan proved again to be the best team in the region.

While winning the trophies in those two competitions, the players and the coaching staff were also setting marvelous scores in the elite European competition, beating giants like Panathinaikos and Real Madrid. The entire Europe went crazy about Partizan performances and fan's atmosphere in Pionir Hall. Partizan needed just one more step to get to the company of four best European clubs but it was not just the rival whom Partizan had to beat in that game to achieve the deserved. They crowned the successful season by leaping over many hurdles in the way. Partizan won the 15th Championship of Serbia in the clubs history and the 7th consecutive title and qualified again for the most important European contest- Euroleague.

Dvorana „Pionir“ zvanično je otvorena 24.05.1973. godine. Izgrađena je po projektu arh. Ljiljane i Dragoljuba Bakića. Radove je izveo „Energoprojekt“ iz Beograda u roku od 11 meseci. Korisna površina dvorane je 16.000 kvadratnih metara, a površina sportskih borilišta 2.500 kvadratnih metara. Kapacitet tribina je 7.000 mesta. Press centar zadovoljava sve uslove praćenja velikih sportskih manifestacija. Dvorana je pogodna za sve vrste „malih“ sportova, za kulturno-zabavne priredbe, kongresne skupove i druge manifestacije. Od velikih košarkaških događaja u dvorani „Pionir“ održana su Evropska prvenstva za košarkaše 1975. i 2005. godine, EP za juniore 2005. godine, finale Kupa Koraća ( revanš utakmica) i finale Kupa Saporte 1998. godine. ### Grad Beograd

Beograd je glavni grad Republike Srbije (2.000.000 stanovnika). Uz povoljan geografski položaj (grad leži na ušću dve reke, Save i Dunava), Beograd je poznat po veoma bogatoj kulturnoj i sportskoj tradiciji.

The Pionir is today a modern, fully equipped facility than can successfully meet the highest standards, of the top European competition. The EC for junior men was held in PIONIR in July 2005. Also, Pionir hosted national teams of Greece, France, Slovenia and Bosnia in the first round of EC for senior men 2005.

Zatim je usledila jedna sezona u OKK Beograd, gde je vodio juniorsku ekipu se kojom je i osvojio Prvenstvo Jugoslavije. Iste godine je radio i sa prvim timom OKK Beograd.

Posle odluzenog vojnog roka, godinu dana je radio u Mladosti iz Zemuna, da bi se pred sezonu 1985/86 vratio u Partizan, gde je postao pomoćni trener prvog tima. Posle smene šefa stručnog štaba, tokom sezone 1986/87, postaje prvi trener i iste sezone osvaja titulu prvaka Jugoslavije. U sezoni 1987/88 Vujošević je predvodio ekipu do fajnl fora Kupa evropskih šampiona u Ganu, na kome su crno-beli osvojili treće mesto. Sledeće sezone 1988/89 sa Partizanom je osvojio Kup Radivoja Koraća i Kup Jugoslavije.

U sezoni 1989/90 bio je prvi trener španske Uelve iz Granade, da bi se posle toga vratio u Partizan koji je vodio u sezoni 1990/91 i stigao do finala plej ofa. I u narednoj sezoni 1991/92 Vujošević je stigao do finala plej ofa, ovaj put sa Crvenom zvezdom. In the following season (1988/89), Vujošević lead Partizan to the Korac Cup title and the Yugoslav Cup trophy.

In the 1989/90 season, he was Head Coach of the Spanish team of Huelva Granada. The following season (1990/91) Vujošević again led Partizan to the playoffs finals. The very next season he did the same with BC Crvena Zvezda.

From 1992 to 1998, Vujošević successfully worked in Italy with Brescia, Pistoia and Scavolini. Back from Italy, he was Head Coach of Radnički Beograd.

Since his return to Partizan in 2001, he has won seven Champion titles of the state (2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008), two National Cup trophies (2002, 2008) and two NLB League Champion titles (2007, 2008), thus becoming the leading trophy winner in the history of the Club. ## GOLDEN HISTORY KORAC CUP 1978 - 1979 - 1989



**1978. – 2008.**

Jedan od datuma koji su zlatnim slovima upisani u istoriju Partizana je 21. mart 1978.

Posle pobeđe nad dominantnim Huventudom u polufinalu (107:95), crno-beli su za protivnika u odlučujućem meču za Žučkovu levicu imali sarajevsku Bosnu. U veličanstvenom finalu predvođen Draganom Kićanovićem i Draženom Dalipagićem Partizan je posle produžetka savladao Bosnu sa 117:110 (101:101). Tim Partizana sačinjavali su Dragan Todorić, Dragan Kićanović, Dušan Kerkez, Boban Petrović, Milenko Babić, Miodrag Marić, Jadran Vujačić, Boris Beravs, Arsenije Pešić i Dražen Dalipagić. Ranko Žeravica, kao šef stručnog staba i njegov asistent Dušan Ivković predvodili su tim do prvog međunarodnog trofeja.

**1989. – 2009.**

Generacija koja je ostavila najdublji trag u Partizanovoj istoriji, prvi evropski trofej osvojila je početkom proleća 1989. godine. Istorijski dueli sa Vivom iz Kantua i danas se prepričavaju. U prvom duelu, 16. marta, Italijani su domaći teren iskoristili i stekli 13 poena za revanš (89:76).

Sedam dana kasnije u dupke punoj Palati sportova na Novom Beogradu (7000 gledalaca) crno-beli su za samo 450 sekundi dostigli prednost VIVE, na kraju slavili sa 101:82.

Drugu Žučkovu levicu u Partizanove vitrine doneli su: Aleksandar Đorđević, Predrag Danilović, Predrag Prlinčević, Jadran Vujačić, Milenko Savović, Miladin Mutavdžić, Vlade Divac, Oliver Popović, Žarko Paspalj i Ivo Nakić. Na kormilu stručnog štaba crno - belih kao i danas bio je Duško Vujošević.

### Crno-bele Žučkove levice

Partizan je osvojio tri Kupa Radivoja Korača u vreme kada je ovo takmičenje imalo međunarodni karakter. Zanimljivo je da su dve od tri Žučkove levice osvojene u godinama koje su se završavale brojem 9 – 1979. i 1989.

Ovo je prilika da se podsetimo svih Partizanovih osvajača prestižnog evropskog trofeja.

## 1978. – 2008.

One of the golden dates in the Partizan's history was 21st March 1978.

After the victory in semifinals against dominant Huventud 107:95 Partizan faced team from Sarajevo - Bosna. In magnificent final, Partizan led by Dragan Kicanovic and Drazen Dalipagic defeated Bosna 117:110 in overtime.

The winners of The Korac Cup 1978 were Dragan Todoric, Dragan Kićanović, Dušan Kerkez, Boban Petrović, Milenko Babić, Miodrag Marić, Jadran Vujačić, Boris Beravs, Arsenije Pešić, Drazen Dalipagić. Ranko Zeravica, as a head coach, and his first assistant Dusan Ivkovic led this team to its first international trophy.



## Partizan's Korac trophies

Partizan has won three Korac Cup Trophies when this competition was international. The interesting fact is that two of three trophies were conquered in the years which had number 9 at the end - 1979 and 1989. This is an opportunity to mention all the winners of this prestigious European trophy.

## 1989. – 2009.

The generation of players with biggest success in Partizan's history, has won its first European trophy in early spring 1989.

In the first game of historical duels with Viva from Kantu, 16th March, Italians had advantage of the thirteen points on home court. Seven days later in front of 7,000 spectators for just 450 seconds «black and white» cut the gap from first game, and celebrated victory at the end 101:82.

The winners of second Partizan's Korac trophy were: Aleksandar Đorđević, Predrag Danilović, Predrag Prlinčević, Jadran Vujačić, Milenko Savović, Miladin Mutavdžić, Vlade Divac, Oliver Popović, Žarko Paspalj and Ivo Nakić. That team had the same head coach as «black and white» have today - Dusko Vujosevic.
