Kakva su to bila srca u galopu. Video sam umorne od sreće, srećne od umora. U Pioniru i Areni. Kakva je to bila harmonija igrača i navijača, kakav sklad Grobara i Grobara.

I zato je Šekspir u pravu kada kaže: nema veće vlastele od grobara. I Šekspir je Grobar. Članska karta broj 1564. Vođa navijača iz Fuanlabrade i Stenforda.

Prvak na srpskom znači Partizan. I zato sad ovim evropskim martom neka Partizan pregazi Jadran i Srbiju.

Košarkaški klub Partizan je najuspešniji kolektiv u našoj zemlji. U svojoj bogatoj istoriji, dugoj više od šest decenija, KK Partizan je osvojio čak 33 trofeja. Crno-beli košarkaši 16 puta su bili prvaci države – 1976, 1979, 1981, 1987, 1992, 1995, 1996, 1997, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 i 2009, deset puta osvajači nacionalnog Kupa – 1979, 1989, 1992, 1994, 1995, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2008 i 2009, tri puta pobednici Kupa Radivoja Koraća – 1978, 1979, 1989, a prvaci Jadranske lige bili su 2007, 2008 i 2009.

Najsajjniji trofej u bogatoj klupskoj riznici, titulu prvaka Evrope, osvojili su u Istanbulu 1992. godine.

KK Partizan je izrastao u najpoznatije košarkaško ime sa naših prostora, sa velikim ugledom u evropskim i svetskim okvirima. Pored zapaženih rezultata i konstatnog učešća u evropskim klupskim takmičenjima, tome je doprinela i plejada reprezentativaca poniklih u Partizanu, koji su doneli slavu našoj košarki širom sveta, osvajajući medalje sa državnim timom. Nijedan evropski klub nije dao toliko igrača najjačoj ligi na svetu, NBA, kao beogradski crno-beli, a košarkaši koji su nosili dres Partizana uvek su bili znak prepoznavanja zemlje i višestrukih evropskih i svetskih prvaka.

BC Partizan is the most successful basketball club in Serbia. During its more than six decades long history, Partizan has won as many as 33 trophies. The "Black and White" players were the state champions sixteen times (1976, 1979, 1996, 1997, 2002, 2003, and 2009), they won the National Cup ten times (1979, 1989, 1992, 1994, 1995, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2008 and 2009), three times they won the European Cup Radivoje Korac (1978, 1979, 2008, 2009). The most significant trophy the club has won is the European Champion's Cup at the Final Four of the European Champion's Cup in Istanbul in 1992.

BC Partizan has grown into the most famous basketball brand from Serbia and team acclaimed both on the European and World levels. Partizan has earned respect not only by winning and constantly participating in the European competitions, but also thanks to a multitude of its players that have worn the jersey of the National team, the squad who has conquered the world earning fame and trophies for our country. No European team has given as much players in the world best league NBA as Partizan did and they have always been the trademark of the country which was multiple European and World basketball champion.

OSVRT - A LOOK BACK 2008/2009



Košarkaški klub Partizan. KK Partizan. Crno-beli. I u prethodnoj sezoni, najbolji. Sezona 2007/2008 je okarakterisana kao jedna od najuspešnijih u istoriji kluba, osvojena su sva tri trofeja, plasman u osam najboljih timova Evrope. Kažu da je trofeje lakše osvajati nego braniti. Crno-beli u sezoni 2008/2009 nisu dozvolili da trofej Kupa Radivoja Korača napusti trofejnu salu u Humskoj, regionu su sasvim jasno pokazali da titula u NLB ligi ne menja vlasnika, a u domaćem prvenstvu su nastavili svoju dominaciju. Malo bi bilo reći da su ih samo branili, tri trofeja su i ove sezone osvojena!

Čarobne partije Duletovih pulena u Evropi, ponovo su zasenile sve ljubitelje igre pod obručima. U utakmicama punim preokreta nizale se pobede u Pioniru, kao i na strani, navijači su ispratili crno-bele prvo u šesnaest, a potom i u osam najboljih timova Evrope. Uspeh iz prethodne preselio se i u narednu sezonu. Uz jednu „manju“ dopunu: tim Partizana 2008/2009 i verni navijači kluba iz Humske, ponosni su vlasnici rekorda posećenosti jednoj utakmici Evrolige. Kao kruna ponovljenog uspeha, Beogradska Arena bila je ispunjena do poslednjeg prostora, a prizor prve klupske utakmice u najvećoj dvorani na Balkanu ostao je zabeležen u istoriji našeg kluba, sportskog društva, grada i države.

I po završetku sjajne košarke godine, priznanja su stizala u Humsku. Sportski savez Beograda dodelio je Majsku nagradu našem klubu, Duško Vujošević dobio je najveće trenersko priznanje, nagradu Aleksandar Gomeljski, a Evroliga je odlučila da na turneju po Americi u susret NBA timovima povede upravo crno-bele.

The Cup of Radivoj Korač walk away from the club's trophy room, they did show the region who are the back-to-back-to-back champions of the NLB league, and continued the domination in the National League winning it for the eighth consecutive time. It is hard to say that the trophies were just won, ALL three trophies were defended in the last season.

Magical games, Dule's favourites displayed in Europe, amazed the complete basketball audience in Europe. The Black and Whites were winning the thriller matches through the whole season, beating bitter rivals in Pionir and away, the fans were magical again and supported their club to the Euroleague's best 16 and then to the Top 8 proving to be the creme del'a creme of Europe. The success from the previous season was repeated with a slight step further: Partizan 2008/2009 team and the true fans of the Humska club broke the attendance record of the Euroleague. The crown of the amazingly successful season was the fact that the Belgrade Arena was packed to its full capacities. Moreover, the first basketball game of the clubs played in Arena will be marked as the most visited in the club's history, the history of the Sports Association and the history of Belgrade and Serbia.

And... the magnificent basketball season was properly rewarded as the recognitions for the great work started arriving in Humska 1. Sports Association of Belgrade presented our club with the 'May Award' for great sports achievements, the Head Coach Duško Vujošević was awarded with the prestigious Aliaksandr Gomeljski prize as the best European coach in the season, while the Black and Whites received the invitation for the NBA tour in order to represent the Euroleague in the USA.

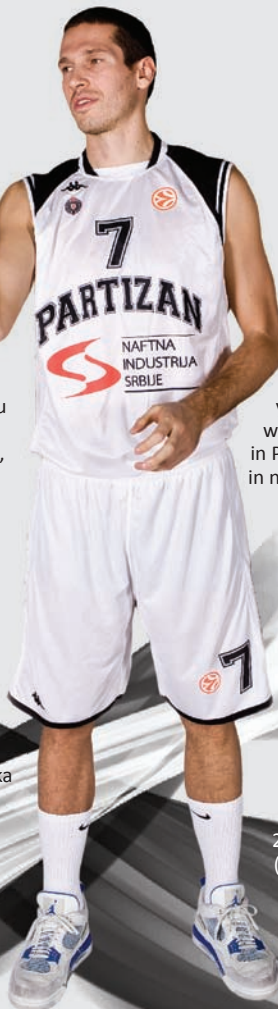

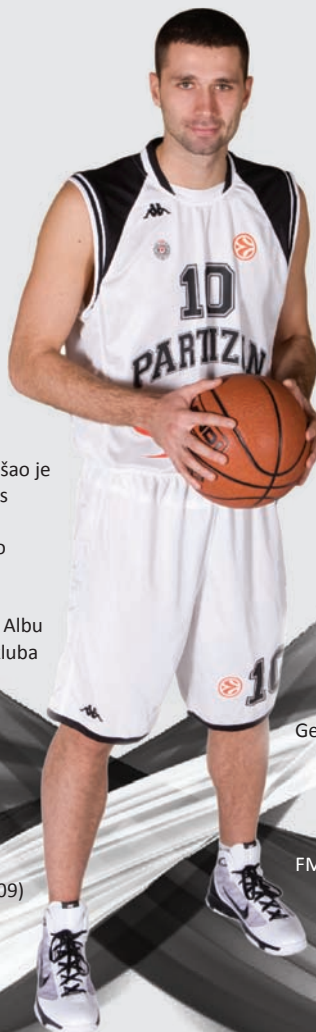

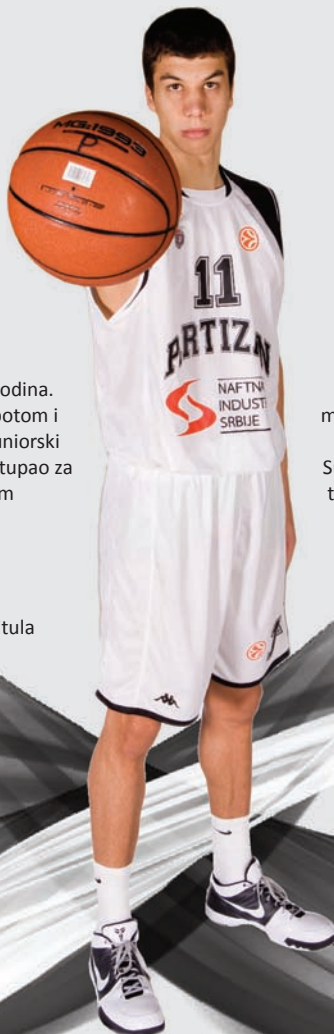

Duško Vujošević je trenerskim poslom počeo da se bavi još kao sedamnaestogodišnjak, 1976. godine. Sve do 1982. godine radio je sa mladim kategorijama u Partizanu. Zatim je usledila jedna sezona u OKK Beograd, gde je vodio juniorsku ekipu se kojom je i osvojio Prvenstvo Jugoslavije. Iste godine je radio i sa prvim timom OKK Beograd.

Posle odsluženog vojnog roka, godinu dana je radio u Mladosti iz Zemuna, da bi se pred sezonu 1985/86 vratio u Partizan, gde je postao pomoćni trener prvog tima. Posle smene šefa stručnog štaba, tokom sezone 1986/87, postaje prvi trener i iste sezone osvaja titulu prvaka Jugoslavije. U sezoni 1987/88 Vujošević je predvodio ekipu do fajnal fora Kupa evropskih šampiona u Ganu, na kome su crno-beli osvojili treće mesto. Sledeće sezone 1988/89 sa Partizanom je osvojio Kup Radivoja Koraća i Kup Jugoslavije.

U sezoni 1989/90 bio je prvi trener španske Uelve iz Granade, da bi se posle toga vratio u Partizan koji je vodio u sezoni 1990/91 i stigao do finala plej ofa. I u narednoj sezoni 1991/92 Vujošević je stigao do finala plej ofa, ovaj put sa Crvenom zvezdom. Od 1992. do 1998. godine radio je u Italiji gde je sa uspehom vodio ekipe Breše, Pistoie i Skavolinija. Po povratku u Italije u sezoni 1998/99 bio je šef stručnog štaba podgoričke Budućnosti, a od 1999. do 2001. godine vodio je beogradske Radničke.

Od ponovnog povratka u Partizan 2001. godine osvojio je sedam titula prvaka države (2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007 i 2008), dva nacionalna Kupa (2002 i 2008) i dva trofeja NLB lige (2007 i 2008). I tako je postao najtrofejniji trener u istoriji kluba.

Kao trener juniorske reprezentacije Jugoslavije osvojio je prvenstvo Evrope u Vrbasu 1988. godine i četvrto mesto na Svetskom juniorskom prvenstvu 1991. godine. Vujošević je trener koji je poznat po izvanrednom radu sa mladim igračima. Radio je sa sjajnom generacijom igrača koji su svetsku afirmaciju stekli upravo u Partizanu (Danilović, Đorđević, Divac, Paspalj...) Poznat je kao stručnjak koji ukazuje šansu mladim igračima.

U proleće 2003. godine postavljen je za selektora seniorske reprezentacije Srbije i Crne Gore, sa kojom je na Evropskom prvenstvu u Švedskoj osvojio šesto mesto.

Duško Vujošević began his coaching career as a seventeen year old in 1976. Until 1982 he coached various junior teams in Partizan. After that, he moved to OKK Beograd for one season to lead the junior team to the Yugoslav title. The same year he worked with the seniors of OKK Beograd.

After his military service, he worked for a year with Mladost Zemun and then returned to Partizan on the eve of the 1985/86 season, to become Assistant Coach. He shortly inherited the Head Coach job after his predecessor was fired and won the European Champions Cup Final Four in Gent and the third place. In the following season (1988/89), Vujošević lead Partizan to the Korac Cup title and the Yugoslav Cup trophy. In the 1989/90 season, he was Head Coach of the Spanish team of Huelva Granada. The following season (1990/91) Vujošević again took Partizan to the playoffs finals, this time with Crvena zvezda.

From 1992 to 1998, Vujošević successfully worked in Italy with Brescia, Pistoia and Scavolini. Back from Italy, he was Head Coach of Radnicki Beograd.

Since his return to Partizan in 2001, he has won seven State Champion titles (2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008), two National Cup trophies (2002, 2008) and two NLB League Champion titles (2007, 2008), thus becoming the leading trophy winner in the history of the Club. As coach of the junior national team of Yugoslavia, he won 1988 the European Championship in Vrbas and he took fourth place on the 1991 World Championship. Vujošević is a coach renowned for his work with young players. He was credited to have produced the formidable generation of players who become famous worldwide, after making their debut in Partizan: Danilovic, Djordjevic, Divac, Paspalj... Loves to give playing time to young players.

In spring 2003, he was appointed head coach of the national team of Serbia and Montenegro. With that team, he has won the sixth place on the European Championship in Sweden. In 2007, he accepted the position of Montenegro national team head coach and this summer he successfully led them through the qualifications for European A Division Championship. Duško Vujošević received May Award and also the prestigious Aleksandar Gomejski Award as the Coach of the Year for 2008/2009 Euroleague season.

Nastupao je za kadetsku, juniorsku i seniorsku reprezentaciju Jugoslavije. Sa reprezentacijom je osvojio zlato na kadetskom Prvenstvu Evrope u Italiji 1971, zlato na juniorskom Prvenstvu Evrope u Zadru 1972, zlato na Mediteranskim - igrama u Alžiru 1977. i zlato na Balkanijadi u Rumuniji 1975. Kao igrač i funkcioner učestvovao je u osvajanju svih 30 klupskih trofeja.

He played for Sloga from Kraljevo from 1967 till 1972. He came to Partizan in 1972. and he is in first team until 1983. In this period he played 363 official games and he is at second place of hall of fame list by the number of played games. He finished his career in OKK Beko from Belgrade in 1985. From then till today he is working in Basketball club Partizan. He was Secretary, General Secretary, Director, Sport Director. He is a member of the Management Board. As a player he won three championships of the state, (1976, 1979, and 1981.) one Yugoslav Cup (1979) and two Korac Cups (1978. and 1979.).

He was playing for cadet, junior and senior national team of Yugoslavia. With them he won gold at cadet Championship of Europe in Italy in 1971, gold at junior Championship of Europe in Zadar in 1972, gold at Mediterranean playing in Algeria in 1977. and gold at Balkanic Games in Romania in 1975. As a player or as a official he took part in the conquest of all 30 Partizan trophy's.

This longstanding tradition has been marked with numerous trophies conquered by our young teams over the years, both on the level of the Republic and on the federal and european level. Many famous players originate from our ranks.

Memorijalni turnir "Haris Brkić" je jedan od najkvalitetnijih turnira mlađih kategorija koji se organizuju na našim prostorima u znak sećanja na tragično preminulog asa Harisa Brkića. Do sada je održan devet puta, u konkurenciji pionira i kadeta. Prva četiri turnira održana su na otvorenim terenima našeg kluba na Malom Kalemegdanu.

Od 2004. godine turnir ima internacionalni karakter, učesnici su klubovi u kojima je Haris Brkić igrao tokom karijere Bosna, Borac, Partizan i Budućnost.

Partizan je šest puta bio šampion ovog turnira, Bosna dva puta, dok je Budućnost osvojila jedan turnir. Prošlogodišnji pobjednik memorijala bio je naš klub - Partizan.

The memorial of "Haris Brkić" is one of the best tournaments for young teams in the region organized in memory of tragically deceased ace Haris Brkic. Up till now the tournament was held nine times, with the participation of U-14 and U-16 teams. The first four tournaments were held at our team's open courts at Mali Kalemegdan.

Since the year 2004 this tournament is international, with the participation of clubs where Haris Brkic played Bosna, Borac, Partizan and Buducnost.

Six times Partizan was the champion of the tournament, Bosna two time, while Buducnost has one trophy. This year winner was our club - Partizan.

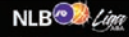

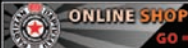
